Activity Participation:

For the all the standard outings clients have the choice to go or stay back and participate in an in-house activity. Clients may choose to participate in zero to all standard outings. This is an opportunity for building choice making skills and budgeting skills.

Special Classes:

We are now offering classes daily. Clients sign up for the class of their choice the morning of the class day. Below is a listing of classes available .

Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday & Friday: Sign Language, Arts & Crafts or Games.

Thursday: Yoga, Bible Study or Personal Errands.

Yoga-We have a certified Yoga instructor that teaches a class on campus.

Personal Errands-This is an opportunity for clients to get some personal shopping done and work on consumer skills while doing it. Clients may bring a list of three items to purchase. Some shopping items may include hygiene items, gifts, stationary etc. No food products. All shopping will be done at Walmart.

Coffee Break:

This is a fun opportunity to work on consumer skills, table manners and interpersonal skills. Clients that wish to participate will be going to a near by coffee shop during our 9:00 break time. Clients may bring money for coffee, tea, hot chocolate, bagel, muffin etc. Clients that are participating in this outing do not need to bring a snack. We will send home a menu prior to our first trip.
